Dear Cam

I write to confirm the following:

- I have received further briefings on ONTRACK's discussions with Toll, including the notes forwarded to me on 26 January.
- I am comfortable with ONTRACK revising its indicative offer for the equity in the entire Toll NZ business to \$575 million, and an indication to Toll that any final offer is likely to be within 10% of this figure.
- I understand that this offer will not be binding until it is approved by the Government and this
 will not occur until ONTRACK has negotiated a sale and purchase contract with Toll, and has
 had access to necessary due diligence information.
- I understand that Toll proposes to retain TranzLink, albeit in a modified form. This transaction structure would be acceptable to the Government. I understand that you propose to negotiate a price reduction from the indicative offer outlined above to reflect the value of the TranzLink business.

Other than the above, my instructions remain as indicated in my letter of 6 December 2007. You should inform Toll that I reserve the right to terminate these negotiations at any time if I view progress as unsatisfactory.
