The objective of changing the management of the IVS and DTS processes is to improve data quality, achieve better accountability and transparency, and increase the flexibility to continuously improve surveys. Progress in achieving this will be measured by:

- Improved timeliness of the releases from 90 days to 21 days;
- Improved access to data (from 40% of the total data available to 100%).
