## **Vote RS&T Savings and Value for Money Reviews**

In response to your letter dated 17 December 2008, I present the findings of the Value for Money (VFM) review of Vote RS&T.

Attached to this letter are two annexes identifying savings for all the Vote RS&T appropriations. Annex 1 includes the major funds and schemes that support research and science activity. Annex 2 [Information deleted in order to maintain the current constitutional conventions protecting the confidentiality of advice tendered by ministers and officials]

The review has not identified any Vote RS&T expenditure that is clearly inconsistent with current government policy. Savings have been identified as well as areas for future VFM reviews.

## **SAVINGS**

Savings in Vote RS&T have been identified in three ways:

- one off savings of \$33.2m available in out years
- unwinding out year increases of \$87.0m from the Economic Transformation package pre-committed against future Budgets [Information deleted in order to maintain the current constitutional conventions protecting the confidentiality of advice tendered by ministers and officials]
