D2 Population, Social and Labour Force Statistical Information Services	28,280	-	3,802	-	32,082	-	Provision of statistics on population and demography, social policy, household economics, the labour market, Census of Population and Dwellings, and the environment; publication of statistical compendia; and maintaining the Streets Directory. The change reflects increases for development work on a Post-censal Disability Survey and for a transfer between appropriations for changes to the distribution of overheads; and reductions for three expense transfers to 2000/01 for deferred outputs from the Survey of Older People in 2000, the Household Savings Survey, and to the development of a Longitudinal Survey of Income Dynamics.
