I strongly urge the Government to retain Section 9 of the SOE Act as is.

Why? [Dion Tuuta](#) sums it up perfectly "[m]any New Zealanders view this clause as a preferential treatment for Maori that has no place in an equal society. I prefer to think of it as an insurance policy that has protected Maori interests as guaranteed by the Treaty. All New Zealanders should be grateful for it. Because without this protection it is plausible that many of New Zealand's state owned assets (and the land they sit on) might have been flogged off to foreign interests a long time ago."
