General Principles of the Treasury Gifts and Hospitality Policy

Principle 1: Treasury staff should not accept gifts or hospitality unless there is a clear business benefit to Treasury.

Principle 2: All gifts or hospitality that could reasonably be seen as undermining the integrity of Treasury staff, Treasury, or the wider State Sector must be refused.

Principle 3: Treasury staff must adhere to the Treasury Conflicts of Interest policy and Treasury Code of Conduct.

Principle 4: Treasury staff must not accept prohibited gifts and hospitality. Treasury policy is that gifts worth less than \$100 may be accepted, provided acceptance is consistent with the principles.

All accepted gifts immediately become the property of Treasury i.e. they are not retained by the recipient.

Gifts worth \$100 or more should be declined, unless the gift is from an international/cultural dignitary or iwi and refusing the gift would cause offence.
