Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Shane Jones

Portfolio **Associate Finance**

On 29 April 2019, Cabinet:

- 1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Shane Jones from New Zealand, from 2 to 4 May 2019, to travel to Denarau Island, Fiji for the annual meeting of the Board of Governors of the Asian Development Bank;
- 2 **approved** the estimated expenditure of for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party, as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- 3 **noted** that he will be accompanied by officials from The Treasury and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade whose travel costs will be met by their respective agencies;
- 4 **noted** that he will also be accompanied by his wife, whose travel costs will be met by him personally;
- 5 **agreed** that in his absence:
 - 5.1 Hon David Parker act as Minister for Infrastructure and Minister for Regional Economic Development;
 - 5.2 Hon Damien O'Connor act as Minister of Forestry;
- 6 **noted** that:
 - 6.1 the House is sitting for one day during his absence;
 - 6.2 leave from Parliament has been approved by the Party Whip.
