## **Latest ICR ratings**

- noted that the Treasury has completed its assessment of the Investor Confidence Rating (ICR) results for six agencies: Auckland District Health Board (ADHB), Capital and Coast District Health Board (CCDHB), Canterbury District Health Board (CDHB), Counties-Manukau District Health Board (CMDHB), Waikato District Health Board (WKDHB) and Waitematā District Health Board (WDHB);
- 2 **approve** the following ICR ratings:

- 5 **noted** that the six DHBs have agreed to take specific actions to improve key aspects of their investment performance;
- **invited** the Minister of Health to discuss the ICR results and the DHBs plans to lift their investment performance over time;

## Next steps with the ICR programme and related work

- 7 **noted** that ICR activity is underway for the next set of agencies and the results will be reported to the Cabinet Government Administration and Expenditure Review Committee from April 2020;
- 8 **noted** there will be an independent review of the ICR in the 2019/20 financial year to inform future ICR assessments.
