# COVID-19 Response and Recovery Fund (CRRF) July Package: Vote Social Development: Technical Decisions

Portfolios Housing / Social Development

On 6 July 2020, Cabinet:

- noted that, in June 2020, Cabinet noted that the Minster of Housing and Minister for Social Development would seek funding for the additional operational costs of \$725,000 required to implement the policy decisions to expand access to the Rent Arrears Assistance Housing Support Product until 31 December 2020 [SWC-20-MIN-0052];
- agreed to fund the additional operational costs referred to in paragraph 1 above associated with the temporary policy changes to expand the Rent Arrears Assistance Housing Support Product;
- **approved** the following changes to appropriations to give effect to the decision in paragraph 2 above, with a corresponding impact on the operating balance and net core Crown debt:

- 4 **agreed** that the changes to appropriations and/or capital injections for 2020/21 in paragraph 3 above be included in the 2020/21 Supplementary Estimates and that, in the interim, the increase be met from Imprest Supply;
- agreed that the expenses incurred under paragraph 3 above be charged against the COVID-19 Response and Recovery Fund (CRRF) established as part of Budget 2020;
