I have decided to release the relevant parts of the document listed above. subject to information being withheld under the following section of the Official Information Act:

- Section 9(2)(g)(i) maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions by or between or to Ministers of the Crown or members of an organisation or officers and employees of any department or organisation in the course of their duty, and
- Section 9(2)(i) enable a Minister of the Crown or any department or organisation holding the information to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, commercial activities.

The Green School project was one of many projects that was recommended to Ministers as part of the 'Infrastructure Reference Group (IRG) Shovel Ready Infrastructure Projects' process. The projects were submitted to the IRG, then a shortlist was provided by Crown Infrastructure Partners, as secretariat to the IRG, to IRG Ministers of projects that could be considered for Government support. The Treasury was asked to provide its own assessment of these projects, and relied on information provided by other agencies, where available, to form a brief assessment. Given the large number of projects, substantive advice was not provided on individual projects.

If this option is progressed, MOE should be the responsible agency as it is the steward of the Education Act, and has the experience required to ensure the school gets the right network provision in place, and education system oversight going forward. This school is a provisionally registered private school. They had a 1 March 2020 roll of 46 students. The Education Review Office (ERO) have a process to complete before the school can get full private school registration. ERO is planning to visit the school in 2021, so if they are successful in receiving full registration this is unlikely until mid-2021. We believe it would be inappropriate to announce or provide government funding for a project that does not yet have the necessary education approvals. Even if the necessary approvals were in place we do not recommend funding for this school.
