Annual Reporting and Audit Timeframes Extensions Legislation Bill: Approval for Introduction

Portfolio Finance

On 5 July 2021, Cabinet:

- noted that the Annual Reporting and Audit Timeframes Extensions Legislation Bill holds a category 1 priority on the 2021 Legislation Programme (must be passed as a matter of law in 2021);
- **noted** that the Bill extends annual report and audit report timeframes in the Crown Entities Act and the Local Government Act relating to the 2020/21 and 2021/22 financial years to mitigate the impacts of a severe auditor shortage on obtaining robust audit opinions on end-of-year reporting;
- **approved** for introduction the Annual Reporting and Audit Timeframes Extensions Legislation Bill [PCO 23930/4.0], subject to the final approval of the government caucus and sufficient support in the House of Representatives;
- 4 **agreed** that the Bill be introduced on or after 5 July 2021;
- agreed that the government propose that the Bill be enacted by 8 July 2021.
