Between 1 November 2020 and 30 May 2022 the Treasury received requests from the New Zealand Taxpayer's Union for the following information.

**1 November 2020:** Green School Loan – Please provide us with the terms of the loan and the criteria (or test) applied by officials in order to determine that it would be a loan and not a grant.

**7 May 2021:** A list of organisations that will be attending the Budget 2021 embargoed briefing and the number each is allowed. Why the numbers have been reduced and the reason for the reduction.

**17 June 2021:** All correspondence on Māori skills and employment initiatives and policies between Treasury and MBIE between the dates of 20 May and 29 May
