Thank you for your Official Information Act (OIA) request, received on 5 October 2022. You requested:

I refer to the government Auckland city council joint analysis of the benefit cost ratios of a proposed city rail link in 2011 and 2012 mentioned in T2015/2811 in paragraph 16. I Request a pdf copy of the joint work with the government and council mentioned in that paragraph.

The Treasury have searched our databases and could not locate any specific information that we hold which relates to the reference provided in your request. In addition, we have consulted with the Ministry of Transport who have advised that they also could not locate any relevant information.

Your request is therefore refused under section 18(e) of the OIA - *the document alleged to contain the information requested does not exist or cannot be found.*

The Treasury believes that information of relevance may be held by Auckland Transport or Auckland Council. As those organisations are not subject to the Official Information Act 1982, your request could not be transferred to them for a response. However, I do encourage that you make contact with them to see if they hold the information.

This reply addresses the information you requested. You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision.
