Thank you for your Official Information Act (OIA) request, received on 15 February 2023. You requested:

*I request under the OIA all advice on re prioritisation delivered between 1 July 2022 and 15 Feb 2023.*

On 16 February 2023, the Treasury contacted you and advised that this request was broad in scope and asked for a clarification on specifically which topics you were interested in receiving information on. You advised the following:

*Any advice that was offered on possible reprioritisations, not just the things that were reprioritised.*

As advised 17 February 2023, even after refining the request, it still constitutes as a request that is too broad in scope. This is because we would have to undertake extensive research across the entire Treasury to see if each team could offer advice on any possible reprioritisations. The Treasury works on a very broad range of topics, so this would be an extensive undertaking. Therefore, your request is refused under section 18(f) of the OIA – *the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.*
